Building management system (BMS) to control and monitor the M & E equipment, power systems, fire systems, and security systems needed if it is not already incorporated.

The building should be of of contemporary design, possibly a motorised roller blinds system that can integrate with a BMS may be more suitable for the space or in some areas timber shutters or metal louvre in Lieu of traditional curtains.
